HEALTH Investment in community health is an issue of 81% utmost importance to Fórsa members with 81% saying they will vote for candidates and parties who make this a priority.

HOUSING

75%

believe the housing crisis has worsened since the last election. This rises to 8 in 10 of those aged 35 vears and under.





Overall, support for a referendum on public ownership of water services (60%) and for affordable childcare (64%) have also increased.
